Dear Corpus Christi Community,

Not long after Easter, I stepped down as your music director, and as of Labor Day 2010, I will be stepping down as the 10:30 choir director.

I want to tell you that this community has made a world of difference in my life. Ten years ago, when I was hired to coordinate the music leaders and direct the contemporary choir, I had no experience as a choir director. I did have a BA in music history, but I didn't know a thing about Catholic liturgy. I had no idea what a cantor was. I could not play the guitar or the piano. I had never had to lead anyone or anything. Frankly, only the Holy Spirit could have called me to take on such a task without the skill or knowledge to do it. Only a community filled with the Holy Spirit could have helped me to become the person I have become today.

With your help, I learned the ropes through countless liturgical meetings, at parish retreats, bible study, National Pastoral Musician's conferences, Guitar and Ensemble School and St Bernard's School of Ministry and Theology. You patiently listened to the choir sing a cappella or with flute while I learned to play the guitar. You forgave my mistakes and shared in our joy when the choir did well. When we began the ministry of cantors, you followed and sang. I can honestly say that I have had so much support over the years. You have always taken the time to say "thanks". The dedication of our new church was such a highlight for me. It was wonderful to lead all of our music ministries and join with you in spirit and song. It was a music program full of diversity and a richness that showcased the various styles and musical tastes that we have incorporated at the different masses. Most of all, people sang and participated with joy in anticipation of our new worship space.

I will miss our music volunteers and leaders who are an incredible group of people. They consistently give of their time and talents. Many of them rehearse every week and often give up holiday time that could have been spent with family and friends. They also understand their work which is to help you to better understand through music, the readings, the seasons and the liturgical actions that take place at mass.

Most of all I will miss hearing you sing. There is nothing more fulfilling for a music director than hearing the voices of the people in the congregation. Full and conscious participation at mass is the goal. When you leave mass feeling as though you have joined with the Body of Christ through prayer and song then we have done our job. When you report that our cantors have helped you to understand a psalm, then we rejoice.

Corpus Christi, you have shown me through the years, exactly what it means to be the Body of Christ. I will never forget that and I will never forget you. Thank you for all that you have done for my family, for me and for my soul.
