Exterior Siding:

Over the next several weeks, we will be replacing exterior siding on certain walls of the Center. This is something that has been needed for a while as you may have noticed the peeling of paint and some rotted boards. **Don Butner, Jr., and Jack Leonard of our Maintenance Staff,** will be doing the work themselves, thereby saving us extra labor costs. We are planning to match the siding on the Church Building, which is comprised of a composite board and is quite durable and requires minimum upkeep. As with all older buildings, it is necessary to routinely maintain our facilities in order to prevent more costly work later on.
