- Cash flow has improved. We have paid this year's Catholic schools assessment in the amount of \$42,000. Father Ed preferred that. It is the first in 5 years we have been able to pay that.
- Pat Kilgore asked about replacement of the stained glass windows. Kris said it not a priority.
- Traditionally, we pay up to \$75,000 a year on roof maintenance. We will spend \$14 to \$15,000 for planned repairs this summer.
- In reply to a question, Kris said it is possible to receive donation of stock. Gail Moore has it set up.
